

# Department 3 – Beef Cattle

See General Livestock information. Entry fee: Adult: \$6.00 per animal; Youth: Free. (Sponsored by Farm Credit)

## Health Rules:

1. Individual official animal identification. Official ID will have a US shield **US** and includes; A USDA-issued National Uniform Eartagging System (NUES) tag; or a 15-digit Animal Identification Number eartag starting with “840”; or other official identification approved by USDA. (Brands and breed registrations with tattoos are not acceptable.)
2. All animals must be free of infectious and contagious diseases and a statement of this is required on the CVI.
3. A Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) **issued after May 1 is required.**
4. A current **rabies** vaccination administered by a licensed veterinarian is required for animals 3 months of age and older. A copy of the rabies vaccination certificate is acceptable. Market cattle are exempt from the rabies vaccination requirement.
5. For a list of vaccination requirements for out-of-state animals call the Fair office.
6. Breed registration papers must be presented upon arrival at the Fair.

## General Rules:

1. All livestock must be shown by the exhibitor that it is registered under unless the exhibitor has more than one animal in the class and then one animal must be shown by the registered exhibitor.
2. When on exhibit in the ring, each animal must be under halter and in charge of owner or owner’s representative.
3. When on exhibit in the ring, Junior exhibitors should have assistance available.
4. No breed exhibits are to be set up in barns. If interested in such an exhibit, consult with the department chairperson for alternative exhibit location.
5. No blocking chutes are permitted inside the beef barn.
6. **Junior Livestock or Open market animals may be shown in breeding or market classes but not both.**
7. **The Livestock Entry Form can be found at the back of this book or on the Premium Book page on the web site at [www.southmountainfair.com](http://www.southmountainfair.com) and must be returned to the South Mountain Fair by July 6, no exceptions.**
8. **Livestock may not be removed before 10:00 p.m. on Saturday and no vehicles or livestock trailers may go to the barns before 10 pm. All premiums will be forfeited by all exhibitors who’s animals are being transported with a vehicle/trailer entering the grounds before 10 pm.**
