## From Barbara . . .

We are all called to holiness. St. Paul tells us that if we have been sanctified by Christ we are called to be holy. We who have been baptized in the Lord have been sanctified. John the Baptizer gives an eyewitness account of the power of the baptism of Jesus. The baptized have received that same power of Christ which is nourished by our reception of Eucharist and Reconciliation on a regular basis. Take time this week to be aware of your holiness and how you nourish it in yourself and others.

You may have heard that starting in Advent 2011 (that's November 27, 2011) we will begin using a New Roman Missal. Primarily this is the prayers of the Mass. There have been some changes made to include the many new saints that have been canonized since the last Roman Missal was published in 1985. Some of the translations have also been changed to be more accurate with the original Latin and also to be more faithful to the scriptural references. Over the next year we will be inserting into the bulletin a variety of inserts that will help us all understand our role in the liturgical celebrations and the changes that are being made. Please take some time to read this inserts and familiarize yourself with why the new Missal is necessary. As we get closer to implementation we will also have the opportunity to gather as parish communities to discuss and hear more about what's happening.

May God continue to bless us all.

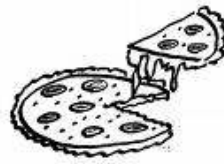
