If income is low for reasons such as unemployment, underemployment, reduced pension benefits, or inadequate health insurance, think of Food Stamps as insurance into which you have paid and which you now need. The Hunger-Free Communities Partnership offers easier access to Food Stamps (actually an electronic card). A HFO Outreach Worker from Catholic Charities will be at St. Anthony office on a regular schedule to assist people who have made appointments. Appointments are made directly with the counselor (*not the parish office*) by calling (443) 939-6031.

## From Barbara . . .

How do you identify God? What words do you use when describing God or talking about your faith in Jesus? Words cannot fully describe God but as humans its one of our primary ways of expressing our understanding. Simon Peter used simple words "the Christ, the Son of the living God." They may be simple but they are profound. Take time this week to imagine how you would describe God to someone who had never had an experience of faith or religion. Would you use words or an image or a sound?
